3. Poll

If the election is contested a poll will take place on Thursday, 6th May 2021.

4. Registration

Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration officer by 12 midnight on Monday, 19th April 2021. Applications can be made online at: www.gov.uk/register-to-vote

5. Absent Votes

New applications to vote by post and amendments or cancellations of existing postal or proxy vote arrangements must be received by the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Market Street, Nelson, Lancashire BB9 7LG by 5 pm on Tuesday, 20th April 2021.

New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Market Street, Nelson, Lancashire, BB9 7LG by 5 pm on Tuesday, 27th April 2021.

Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election applied for on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Market Street, Nelson, Lancashire, BB9 7LG by 5 pm on Thursday, 6th May 2021. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Tuesday, 27th April 2021. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Tuesday, 27th April 2021.
